She worked there for eight years. She then worked for 32 years at the Jefferson Clinic. In 1984, Fred passed away. Beverly married Tom Higgins in 1989. He passed away in 1991.

Beverly enjoyed flowers, and she spent hours tending her garden. She also enjoyed crocheting

and embroidery. Beverly had a special friendship with her sister-in-law, Elsie Hutchison, and

the two went on many adventures together. She was a member of the Central Christian

Church
in Jefferson, IA.

The most precious things in Beverly's life were her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She spent countless hours babysitting and caring for them. When she wasn't taking care of her grandchildren or attending their many activities, she enjoyed creating scrapbooks for each of them, that celebrated their achievements.
